# Tuesday December 3rd, 2019 MCC Holiday Quads

Time control: G/30 with five second delay. Entry fee: \$20 for MCC members, \$25 for nonmembers. Prizes: \$50 to the winner of each quad. Entrants are ordered by rating from highest to lowest. Starting from the top, players are divided into groups of four and play a round robin of three games. If there are players left at the end, the bottom five, six, or seven players play a three round Swiss.

NOTE: This event will be **Dual** rated, US Chess Regular and Rapid ratings will be affected.

## Tuesday, December 10 MCC Holiday Blitz

Six round double Swiss (each round, players play two games with colors reversed for the second game). Time control: G/5 with no delay. Entry fee: \$20 for MCC members, \$25 for nonmembers. Prizes: \$100 1st, \$50 2nd; \$50 to the highest finisher who started in the bottom half of entrants.

NOTE: This event will only be Rated under the US Chess Blitz rating system.

For **both** events:

Registration closes **promptly** at 7:20 pm. If you arrive after that you may not be paired.

If you think you can't arrive by 7:20, please call the club number **before 7:00 PM** and register by phone message.

#### News

The Club will only be meeting for only two Tuesdays in December 2019 (12/3 and 12/10) since the church has events on 12/17 and 12/24, and the last

Tuesday is New Year's Eve (12/31). See above for details of the two separate one-night events we are running.

#### Reminders

Some reminders of tournament chess rules:

- Players must write their move, or enter it on an electronic scorekeeping device, only **after** making it on the board.
- Players must keep score at all times **unless** either player is below five minutes of thinking time before the first time control, or sudden death.
- Players must use only one hand to make all moves (including captures and castling) and must operate the clock with the same hand.

Penalties for all these violations will be a stern warning for a first offense. Subsequent violations may incur a time penalty. Repeated violations of US Chess rules could result in a loss of a game.


# MCC Group Classes; Submit Games for Potential Review:
