The USCF has a very limited list of approved electronic notation devices allowed for tournament play. Two of them appear to no longer be in production, essentially leaving ChessNoteR as the only viable option for those who are interested in no longer having to write down their moves but playing them in visually. When your game is done you can replay it on the device, and you can tell it to email your game to you as a PGN file. After a weekend tournament of five six games, you have the PGNs instantly ready to into your

preferred chess engine for analysis.

### **Standings and Projected Pairings:**

### **Byes: How to Request or Change them**

Once you are entered in an event you can Request or alter your Bye requests.

Remember, Byes must be made on the site no later than **7:15 pm** on the night of play

- Log into NACHessHub
- Find the event that you need to adjust your Byes for
- Go to the Roster page
- Find your name and click on the link in the Byes column for your name.
  - It will say either "Request" or have the round numbers that you have previously requested Byes for.
