Grandmaster Dzhindzicashvili is currently a U.S. National Champion, having tied for that title in July 1983 with Walter Browne and Larry Christian. Other major triumphs of his career include his victory in the 1978 Hastings International ahead of former World Champion Tigran Petrosian, and his win at Lone Pine, the strongest Swiss-system tournament in the world, in 1980. Dzhindzicashvili emigrated to the United States from Soviet Georgia by way of Israel in the mid-1970s and now makes his home in New York. He is currently the fourth-ranked player in the United States.

The American Legion hall (home of the Framingham Chess Club) is located at the intersection of Franklin and Beech Streets. From Route 9, turn south at Framingham Centre onto Union Street, and turn right after two blocks onto Franklin Street. From The Forum, continue down State Street, turn left onto Maple Street, proceed to Franklin Street and turn right. Once on Franklin Street, continue south for 1 1/4 miles to the American Legion.
