April 22, 29; May 6, 13, 20, 27 (Tuesdays): 1986 FRAMINGHAM CHESS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP. 6-SS in a single section, open only to club members. EF: \$10. Prizes: title, trophy and \$50 to 1st; 2nd \$25; 1st Under 1800 \$40; 1st Under 1400 \$30. Defending co-champions: Drew Sarkisian and Alejandro Beltran.

April 22, 29; May 6 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM CONCURRENT QUADS A. Designed for players unable to play in the club championship. 3-RR in 4-player sections; possible 3-SS in bottom section. EF: \$5. Prizes: \$15 to 1st in each section.

May 13 (Tuesday): UNRATED INTRODUCTORY TOURNAMENT. 3-SS, TL 30/SD. EF: FCC members \$3; others \$4. Entry restricted to unrated or rated under 1200. USCF membership or plaque to 1st.

May 13, 20, 27 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM CONCURRENT QUADS B. See April 22 for details.

June 3, 5 (Tuesday, Thursday): TEAM MATCH AGAINST THE WORCESTER CHESS CLUB. First round in Framingham Tuesday, second round in Worcester Thursday.

June 10, 17, 24 (Tuesday): FRAMINGHAM JUNE OCTAGONAL. 3-SS in 8-12 player sections. EF: FCC members \$3; others \$5. Prizes: trophies to 1st each section.

June 14-15 (Saturday-Sunday): 3RD WEST SUBURBAN SUMMER GRAND PRIX. 4-SS in four sections at the American Legion. A major regional tournament with \$1000 projected cash prizes and 10 Grand Prix points. See flyer for details.

July 1 (Tuesday): SEMINAR NIGHT. Instructional seminars on a variety of topics offered by several of the club's leading players.

July 8, 15, 22, 29 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM JULY SECTIONAL SWISS. 4-SS in two sections: Open and Reserve (Under 1600). EF: FCC members \$7, others \$10. September 2, 5 (Tuesday, Friday): TEAM MATCH AGAINST THE BILLERICA CHESS CLUB. First round in Framingham Tuesday, second round in Billerica Friday.
