POLL: MetroWest Chess Club Match vs. Boylston Chess Club

The Boylston Chess Club (in Somerville) would like to host a one day **USCF rated** match against the MetroWest Chess Club. The proposed date is **Sunday**, **May 7**, starting time to be determined. Each player would play the same opponent twice, once as White and once as Black. Ideally the players paired would be no more than 300 points apart. The entry fee would be \$10 and the winning club would take all. The proposed time control would be either the weekend tournament time control of 40/2, SD/1 or the MCC time control of 40/90, SD/30. Fourteen club members so far have said that they would be interested in playing. The maximum number of boards will be 40..

COMPETE:: Club and Class Championship Qualification Standings Through February 2006

Last month qualifiers for the 2006 Club and Class Championships received invitations. They have until March 14th to accept. Thus far, 10 of the 12 have committed to playing in the championships in May.

Meanwhile, two events have already been played that contribute to the qualification cycle for 2007. All MCC regular time control events during the year offer championship points and the amounts are listed in the tournament announcement. To earn points you have to finish in 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in the Open section, 1st or 2nd in the top class section, or 1st in the next highest class section. In case of a tie, players split the points which are rounded up to the next whole number.
