COMPETE:: Club and Class Championship Qualification Standings Through September 2006

We're entering the home stretch of the qualification race for the 2007 Club and Class Championships with only three tournaments remaining. The only change in the standings since last month is the emergence of Chris Chase in the top-10 list due to his clear first in the Open section.
