

# COMPETE:: Club and Class Championship Qualification Standings Through November 2006

The December tournament is the final event in the qualification cycle for the 2007 Club and Class Championships. The top six qualifiers in the club and class championship standings (who accept the invitation) will complete in the 2007 championships to be held in May 2007. The two championship events will be played in separate sections using a 5-RR format (all play all). An U2000 player who qualifies for the club championship has the option of playing in either the club or class championship.

For the second consecutive month, Denys Shmelov swept the Open section and currently has a nine game winning streak including three wins over international masters! Neil Cousin has moved into the 6<sup>th</sup> slot in the club championship standings.

As a reminder, you have to play in at least 4 tournaments during the year to qualify. Players with an "(n)" after their name in the standings have played in only n-events this year. All others have met the four-tournament requirement. The notation "(moved)" means the player has moved out of the area.
