COMPETE:: Club and Class Championship Qualification Standings Through September 2007

We're entering the home stretch for the 2008 Club and Class Championship qualification cycle. Only two events remain on this year's calendar: the 5-rounder in October and the 6-round Stanley Crowe Memorial that will span November and December. There's still a chance for anyone who scores really well in these last two events to earn one of the 6 qualifying placements, especially if they have earned some points already.

This past month John Curdo, Edward Astrachan, and David Harris have moved up in the Club standings. Astrachan has been on a tear. Since June he has won the U2000/U1900 section 3 times and tied for 2nd in the Open section. He's currently on a 17-game unbeaten streak at MCC with 12 wins and 5 draws!

To date, 72 players have earned championship points. The complete list is available on the MCC website and will be posted at the club. Everyone in the top-10 lists below except Elizabeth Kellner has played in at least four events this year and thus has met the 4-tournament requirement to be eligible for next year's championships.
