COMPETE:: Club and Class Championship Qualification Standings Through October 2007

There is only one more event, the 6-round Stanley Crowe Memorial, that counts towards qualification for the 2008 Club and Class Championships. Being the longest tournament of the year it will offer more championship points that any other event. The first six places in each division will automatically qualify for the championships that will be held in April 2008.

This past month there was more movement in the standings than is normally the case this late in the year. John Curdo with two clear Open wins in a row, Edward Astrachan having placed in the last 5 events, and Bennet Pellows scoring a clear second all have moved up in the Club standings. In the Class standings Mika Brattain and James Williams have entered the top-10 with Mika occupying the 5th qualifying slot.

To date, 77 players have earned championship points. The complete list is available on the MCC website and will be posted at the club.
