The MetroWest Chess Club continues its tradition of holding a summer scholastics tournament. This year the event will take place on four Thursdays during July 10, 17, 24, and 31. Players must be under 15 years of age and can enter in one of three sections:

- Challenge: any rating, 4 rounds, G/60
- 1st Reserve: U900, 8 rounds, two G/30 per night
- 2nd Reserve: for unrated players, 8 rounds, two G/30 per night
