News Blog: In the center of the home page there is a block dedicated to News Blog. You can read synopsis of entries there, and click the link to go to the full Google Blogger blog. Note, if you have a "reader" for your laptop or mobile device, you can subscribe by clicking the reader icon, and get automatic notifications of new news items.



Calendar: In the center of the home page there is a block dedicated to Monthly Tournaments. At the bottom there is a link and a calendar icon to take you to the calendar page. There you will see a Google Calendar. You can use the calendar directly, to check for new entries. Note, if you use "Google Calendar" on your laptop or mobile device, you can add the MetroWest CC calendar to your calendar, and get new calendar entries automatically added.
