Event Details

Club is seeking to relocate

As mentioned in a recent new flash the club is actively seeking to relocate due to changes in our rental agreement at our current location. The basic site requirements we are working to have been posted on the home page. There is a lot of activity going on behind the scenes associated with the move. We may also be faced with some tough decisions so we are doing our homework to prepare to make those decisions.

One of our primary objectives is to minimize the impact of the move from altering the fundamental nature of the club. We have a long track record of success with what we have been doing.

Our search for a new location for the club is progressing well.

Projection of when we may move:

- February We will play G/60; d5 at our current location
- March We may be able to select a location in time for March, if not we will continue where we are
- April As things look now may be able to relocate in time for April.

Risks to moving in time for April:

- Negotiations on our viable sites may not end in time to select the site
 we want to move to
 - o E.g. Their approval cycle pushes out our start date
- We may decide on our location but they may not have everything in place to have us start playing in time.
 - E.g. Tuesday nights will not be free in time for us, they want to purchase their own tables and chairs.
- All our current negotiations fall through and our less likely opportunities have to be vetted.
 - We are searching in order of what we believe to be higher to lower probability of success.
 - We intend to try and vet every candidate site so we don't miss out on some possibly great location.

Search Status

- Over 70 locations to rent are on our list located in primarily in Natick and Framingham
 - 10 sites rejected
 - 35 contacted and assessing
 - 4 in negotiations
- Leasing opportunities research is behind schedule
