## BRITISH CHESS CHAMPION NIGEL SHORT TO GIVE EXHIBITION IN FRAMINGHAM

On Saturday, October 27 at 2 PM International Grandmaster Nigel Short will give a simultaneous exhibition at the Civic League hall, 214 Concord Street (Route 126), Framingham. Short, who won the British Championship last month, will play approximately 20 local players simultaneously. Board fee for participants is \$12; spectators welcome free.

At age 19, Nigel Short is currently the youngest International Grandmaster in the western world. He first gained recognition in Britain when at age 11 he defeated Victor Kortchnoi in a simultaneous exhibition. But he stunned the British chess world a year later when he qualified for the British Championship, at 12 the youngest by four years ever to do so. By that time he had already passed 2200 on the Elo scale and gained his Master's title. At 15 he was the silver medallist at the 1980 World Junior Championship, behind Kasparov; his rating had broken past the 2500 mark. Last November Short won an international tournament in Baku, in Soviet Azerbaijan; this was only the third time in history a non-Soviet player had won a tournament in the Soviet Union. This August he won his Grandmaster title at last in a Danish tournament before capturing the 1984 British Championship last month with a 8 1/2-2 1/2 score, defeating among others redoubtable British GM Tony Miles and Commonwealth Champion Plaskett.

While Short's only currently-scheduled appearance on this trip will be in Framingham (his first appearance ever in the US), arrangements are now being made for Short to return in January to play a match here in Massachusetts against US Champion Lev Alburt. The match is to be staged for regional cable TV. Probable sponsors of the \$14,000 match are the American Chess Foundation and the Massachusetts Chess Association; tax-deductable contributions earmarked for the Alburt-Short match may be sent to MACA, c/o Gilbert Gosselin, 17 Kenney Street, New Bedford MA 02746.

The simultaneous exhibition on October 27 will be sponsored by the Framingham Chess Club.
