FOUR TIE ATOP THE FRAMINGHAM OPEN

Four Senior Masters--FM Ilya Gurevich of Worcester MA, John Curdo of North Billerica MA, David Griego of Providence RI, and Rick Bauer of Farmington CT--shared first through fourth places at 3-1 in the 4th Framingham Open, held September 19-20 in Framingham MA. A half-point out of the prize money at $2\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$ were Lou Mercuri of Newton MA and Alan Shaw of Somerville MA, though Bijan Haririan of Maynard MA, also at $2\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$, won top Under-2200 honors.

The four eventual prizewinners all started strongly with wins in the first round against high-rated Experts, though Bill Kelleher of Boston MA, the fifth-seed, uncharacteristically lost the thread of an endgame and was upset by Drew Sarkisian of Oxford MA, despite being up the exchange earlier. Mercuri, the sixth-seed, yielded a draw to George Winsor of Attleboro; it was to be Winsor's only score of the tournament.

In round two Bauer upset Gurevich after Gurevich blundered away the exchange in the early middlegame. Accepting Gurevich's resignation, Bauer commented that he couldn't recall the last time he had seen Gurevich lose a game. Curdo was held to a draw by Shaw, and Griego yielded a draw to Gary Nute, now of Lowell MA, so Bauer became the sole leader after only two rounds.

Bauer and Curdo battled to a draw in the third round, allowing Griego to join Bauer in the lead with a win over Shaw. Mercuri later made it a three-way tie for the lead, puncturing Nute's Caro-Kann Defense and systematically stripping Nute's king of defenders. Gurevich defeated Jim Anderson of North Quincy MA to move within a half-point of the lead; Anderson essayed one of the sharpest lines of the Ruy Lopez, hoping to turn Gurevich's own weapons against him, without success.

In the finale Bauer and Griego launched into the sharp Meran Defense, suggesting that each was bidding for clear first, but then unexpectedly agreed to a draw after ten moves. Mercuri's fate was thus left in his own hands: he could take clear first with a win over Gurevich. However, despite an early advantage in space, Mercuri handicapped himself with several weak pawns, and Gurevich methodically mopped him up to join the prizewinners. Curdo meanwhile handed Nute a second straight loss to make it a four-way deadlock.

In other sections, John Loyte of Maynard and Stephen Gradijan of Needham MA, the ninth- and tenth-seeds in the Premier (under-2100) section, each scored three wins and drew with each other in the final round to finish equal first with $3\frac{1}{2}-\frac{1}{2}$ scores. Jonathan Crutchley and Mike Grant, both of Boston MA, finished a half-point back. Jerry Williams of Woonsocket RI was the only clear section winner in the tournament, finishing $3\frac{1}{2}-\frac{1}{2}$ to top the Amateur (under-1800) section. Greg Levey of Hadley MA, Steven McDaniel of Worcester MA, and Matthew Rothman of Randolph MA shared second through fourth with 3-1. There was a three-way tie for first in the Reserve (under-1500) section, including Stephen S. Britten of Lexington MA, Ralph Sneiderman of Lynn MA, and Bill Maynard of Charlton MA, all at 3-1. Warren Pinches directed for the sponsoring Framingham Chess Club.
