

WEST SUBURBAN WINTER GRAND PRIX CHESS TOURNAMENT, FEBRUARY 4-5, 1984, FRAMINGHAM

The region's newest tournament, in a modern, easily accesible site with \$1,500 guaranteed cash prizes in six sections with scaled entry fees.

DATE & SITE: February 4-5, 1984, late registration closes at 9:15AM, Round One at 10AM. The tournament will be at The Forum, Framingham State College Center, Route 9 & Edgell Road, Framingham.

FORMAT: The event will be a five-round Swiss in six sections, US Chess Federation rated. Time limit will be 50 moves in two hours. Sections are:

- CHAMPIONSHIP: Open to any player, but usually reserved for top competitors.
- PREMIER: Open to players rated below 2100 or unrated.
- CLASSIC: Open to players rated below 1900 or unrated.
- AMATEUR: Open to players rated below 1700 or unrated.
- BOOSTER: Open to players rated below 1500 or unrated.
- NOVICE: Open to players rated below 1300 or unrated.

PRIZES: There is a fully guaranteed prize fund of \$1,500.
